

RECORD KEEPING

The Deniliquin P&A Society will be keeping a record of the name, contact number and entry time for all staff, customers, and contractors for a period of at least 28 days. Contact details must be collected for each person using a contactless electronic method, such as a QR Code or Similar. Processes must me in place to ensure that customers provide the required contact information. The Deniliquin P&A Society must provide records the NSW Health as soon as possible, but within 4 hours, upon request.
